EFFECTIVE JULY 1ST, 2020 BLUE BAGS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED UNDER RECYCLE BC REGULATIONS

All acceptable curbside recycling must be placed inside the clear, reusable tote provided & placed curbside on your regular garbage day on an alternating week schedule (see reverse) for collection. ONLY these 2 categories are eligible for curbside collection and must be separated by each of the 2 categories. Separate one reusable bag or container in the home for all paper & cardboard products and another for all plastic, metal and paper containers (see examples). Recyclables will be collected by category in the clear tote you have been provided on an alternating week schedule as per the reverse of this card. For example – if your garbage day is Thursday, you will place only your paper/cardboard recycling in your tote alongside your regular household garbage at the curb for collection. The next week, you'll place only your container recycling in your tote curbside and continue this alternating, weekly schedule. All recyclables must be free of food residue. Large corrugated cardboard that does not fit in your tote, is not accepted curbside but can be recycled at the designated receptacles around town or at the Eco-Depot. All other recyclable materials not accepted for curbside collection (i.e. glass, Styrofoam & plastic film) are accepted directly at the Eco-Depot. Questions?
