1. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

2. 2024 BUDGET DISCUSSION (2nd Review) - C. Young, Finance Officer

The Finance Officer provided an overview of the 2024 draft budgets that were originally presented for review at the previous Council Meeting:

a. LCIP BUDGET

- The proposed line item in wages is slightly higher for the additional staff time anticipated for expected development work in the area.
- The Health & Safety line-item increase is for the required WorkSafe policy and procedure development for the new infrastructure.

b. RIVERWALK BUDGET

 Repairs & Maintenance line item includes a lift pump replacement part that was required as Siska's lift pump failed in previous years and that had been borrowed from the Riverwalk system and will be held in inventory.

c. WATER BUDGET

- Increased R/M water breaks line item for any potential water leak repairs that may result after the planned leak detection assessment and the hydrovac of the lines.
- North Reservoir roof replacement can be done in-house but as only one employee remains on staff that has undertaken the chain-link fence installation training, this planned work will be contracted out.
- It was noted that Confined Space safe-work program update has been spread out in all the budgets and is based on the number of members in each department.

d. SISKA BUDGET

• The data/ cloud server system will be put in place with a communication upgrade which will also include small monthly fees for the service.

e. GENERAL OPERATIONAL BUDGET.

- The purchase of an electronic advertisement board for the Bandshell was proposed to be considered. Staff will research options.
- The accurate revenue for the contract with the province for highway rescue in 2023 was corrected at \$14,800.
- It was noted there may be a possible error with the School Tax line item and staff will investigate.
- The Recreation Committee is to report back with more information with a breakdown of anticipated costs for each individual event including the addition of the Block Party.
- A rebuild is required for the backhoe cylinder.
