BYLAW NO. 0004

A BYLAW FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION  
AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT

---

**WHEREAS** under Section 77 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* the Council must designate a person as the head of the local public body for the purposes of administering the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the District of Barriere, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Title

This bylaw may be cited as “DISTRICT OF BARRIERE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY BYLAW 2007 NO. 0004”

2. Definitions

“Act” means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.B.C., 1996 Chapter 165 as amended from time to time

3. The definitions contained in Schedule 1 of the Act shall apply to this bylaw except where the context requires otherwise.
4. The Director of Corporate Administration is designated as the “Head” for the purposes of the Act.
5. The schedule of Maximum Fees as established as established by British Columbia Regulation 323/93, as amended from time to time, shall be the maximum fees charged by the District as permitted under the Act.
