

BYLAW NO. 92

DISTRICT OF BARRIERE

A BYLAW TO AMEND DISTRICT OF BARRIERE BYLAW NO. 1644 AND AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 89 TO REGULATE AND MANAGE THE BARRIERE COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM

The Council of the District of Barriere, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. "GENERAL REQUIREMENTS" amended by renumbering the following section:
 - "25) It is mandatory for all property owners that are connected to the municipal water service to participate in the water meter replacement and upgrade program and as such must allow Neptune Technology Group Ltd. to complete the required water meter installation, replacement or upgrade inside their home."
 - to:
 - "55) It is mandatory for all property owners that are connected to the municipal water service to participate in the water meter replacement and upgrade program and as such must allow Neptune Technology Group Ltd. to complete the required water meter installation, replacement or upgrade inside their home."
- 2. "GENERAL REQUIREMENTS" further amended by the addition of the following sections:
 - 56) In addition to pit meter installation at the property line of Mobile Home Parks, Mobile Home Parks will not have individual meters installed for each mobile home unless requested by the owner of the Mobile Home Park.
 - 57) In the case of property owners refusing installation of a water meter within or under their dwelling, a note from a physician certifying a health issue relating to the sensitivity of radio frequency (rf) is required in order for the District to fund an alternative pit location.
 - 58) With the exception of Section 57), property owners not complying with Section 55) will be subject to a water rate fee of \$300.00 per month.

3. This Bylaw may be cited as "Barriere Community Water System Amendment Bylaw No. 92, amending Bylaws No. 1644 and No. 89,"
