**MUNICIPAL TICKETING INFORMATION BYLAW NO. 71
AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 148**

A Bylaw to amend the Municipal Ticketing Information (MTI) System Bylaw

The Council of the District of Barriere in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the “***District of Barriere Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw No.71, Amendment Bylaw No. 148.***”
2. The Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw No. 71 be amended to remove the existing Schedule A and replace it with the Schedule A attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.
3. *The Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw No. 71 is further amended by deleting Section 5 “Fines, not greater than the amount prescribed by legislation, shall be as designated in the District of Barriere Fees Bylaw, as amended from time to time.” and replacing it with Section 5: “Fines, not greater than the amount prescribed by legislation, are listed in Column 5 of Schedule A as amended.”*
4. *The Municipal Ticketing Information Bylaw No. 71 is amended by adding Section 7: “Any person charged with an offence under a bylaw listed in Schedule A as amended and ticketed under this bylaw as amended, has within 30 days from the date of ticket issuance to notify the District of Barriere in writing of intent to dispute charges.”*
