It was noted that one issue is that the previous classification of the facility is Class A and in reality it should be a Class C, so if the District were to take discharge of effluent for irrigation off as it is not something that has ever been done by the SAWRC facility, and there are no plans to do, this would address some of the issues in the letter.

Staff are in the process of addressing each item noted in the document, are prepared to send a formal response outlining the planned actions and will keep Council informed as to the status going forward.
