BYLAW NO. 213**

A BYLAW FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND REMUNERATION FOR ELECTION
OFFICIALS FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN THE DISTRICT OF BARRIERE

WHEREAS Section 41 of the Local Government Act RS Chap. 323 requires Council to determine procedures and requirements to be applied to the conduct of local government elections and other voting, and

WHEREAS Council of the District of Barriere must appoint municipal election officials, and

WHEREAS Council wishes to establish remuneration rates for municipal officials,

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of the District of Barriere, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. 1.1 This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "*Election Officials Bylaw No.213*".
- 1.2 "*Election Officials Bylaw No. 0015, 2008*" is hereby repealed.

ELECTION OFFICIALS

2. 2.1 Council shall appoint a Chief Election Officer and a Deputy Chief Election Officer.
- 2.2 The Chief Election Officer must appoint election officials required for the administration and conduct of the election as deemed necessary for the election.
- 2.3 All appointed election officials shall perform their appointed duties as stated in the Local Government Act.

REMUNERATION

4. 4.1 Election Officials shall be remunerated as follows:
 - a) Chief Election Officer - \$800.00
 - b) Deputy Chief Election Officer - \$650.00
 - c) Election Officials - \$350.00/day
Including Advance Poll Staff
 - d) Counters - \$60.00 – General Election Day
