#### Trade Show Information

We encourage all our Sponsors to take part in the trade show at the Classic Sheep Sale. There will be space outside the main hall near the main event which will wrap around the building. Also indoor space can be available but is limited to table booths. Both areas are monitored by security at night and will be locked up.

At the last Classic we hosted at Barriere we had over 300 to 500 people or more a day attended. We don't just attract sheep producers but all types of Farmers in BC. Most sheep operations are mixed operations and have all types of farming from Hay to Vegetable to Beef. Hobby operations to Large Scale Ranches,

#### Timeline of Events:

- **July 5** Setup starts at <u>9am</u>, indoor will shut doors at <u>8pm</u>, outdoors must be in place by <u>8pm</u> as well. There will be food service in the PM but not AM
- **July 6 9** am Trade Show will open , Breakfast to Dinner will be available, Junior Sheep Show and Market Lamb will be happening. All sheep producers will be on site and spectators will be present for the days events. Trade show will close at **7pm**
- **July 7 9am** Trade show will open. Breakfast to Dinner will be available, All Canadian Sheep Show will start at **9am** go until late afternoon. Trade show will close at **7pm**. Banquet will follow
- July 8 <u>9am</u> Trade show will open. Buyers Breakfast can be attended and encouraged. All Canadian Sheep Sale will start at <u>9am</u> and run until afternoon. After the conclusion of sale, trade show will close and removal can occur, <u>approx 2pm</u>
