CAO UPDATE:

Community Relations:

- Attended a Lions Club Meeting.
- Simpcw First Nation has postponed Council to Council meeting on February 28th until March 28 @ 4:00pm in Chu Chua to discuss the Crown Land Tenure Application and the 5-year Capital project plan.

Development Projects:

- The Leonie Creek Dam option review continues. The Disaster Risk Reduction grant application for the ongoing assessment work was submitted this past week.
- ➤ LCIP Water Reservoir Project Borrow Enterprises out of Clearwater was awarded the contract to install the new reservoir, with the best bid. The construction schedule has been established and permits in place with Work Safe BC.
